

Maverick

Some articles rely on look-at-me colors or exaggerated textures to make a lasting impression, but Maverick is more self-assured than that. Intensely durable, this thick and husky leather has a nostalgic quality suggestive of a bygone era; the sort of leather you might have found in a smoking room in the 1950s or used as a battle garment during the Middle Ages. The muted earth tones are dark and sultry with a barely-there sheen.

SPILLTOP leather is rated 90-100 with minimal-to-no sticking or wetting of the article's surface.

- 100 – No sticking or wetting of specimen face
- 90 – Slight random sticking or wetting of specimen face
- 80 – Wetting of specimen face at spray points
- 70 – Partial wetting of specimen face beyond spray points
- 50 – Complete wetting of the entire specimen face beyond spray points
- 0 – Complete wetting of the entire face of the specimen

CARE & CLEANING

Routine dusting or vacuuming is encouraged. To add luster and longevity, rotate article periodically and avoid direct sunlight. For spills, gently blot area with cloth or sponge without applying force. If needed, dampen cloth or sponge with warm water. Do not use a hair dryer. Do not use saddle soap, solvents, oils, polishes, varnishes, detergents, bleach or ammonia.
